## New LIFE Courses Coming

A new Life Course, *Life @ Full Capacity*, will be held at RBC at 6 p. m. February 3 - March 9 (6 sessions). Each session is 1 ½ hours. The course is designed to offer practical and personal solutions to key relationships based on the biblical principles found in Matthew 5. C. V. Bailes will be our facilitator. To sign up, call or visit the church **no later than January 27**. A second course, *From Heaven's View* will begin on March 30 and end on May 25. The nine-week journey is a deeply spiritual study which teaches participants how to see themselves and others from God's perspective. Information on a facilitator and sign-up deadline will follow. In addition to the two new LIFE Courses offered this Spring, RBC will also be hosting an online Quiet Time/Bible Study utilizing the Gospel of Matthew.
