## Mission Opportunities

Read over the list of proposed projects and you'll see that we have service opportunities for everyone. If you haven't already done so, please contact the church office to indicate which projects you would prefer on April 19.

### Project 1: Safe Haven Landscaping

Put on your garden gloves and get ready to rake, mulch, and plant flowers and shrubs.

Time: half-day\*

### Project 2: Safe Haven Spring Cleaning

Help spruce up this temporary home for domestic violence victims. Top to bottom cleaning planned from windows, floors, carpets, to ceiling fans including bathrooms and kitchen. Decorating would also be appreciated.

Time: 4 – 5 hours\*

### Project 3: Person County Group Home Retreat Center

Several landscaping projects (around signs, replacing landscape timbers with rocks) need to be done at this site.

Time: all day\*

### Project 4 Person Family Medical Center

Two indoor tasks: move boxes and file medical records in numerical order on shelves.

Outdoor project: Mulch and plant spring flowers.

Time: 4 – 5 hours\*

### Project 5: Senior Center Refurbishing

Remove wallpaper in bathroom and re-paint walls.

Time: all day\*

### Project 6: Senior Center Handyman Special

Install doorbell and shutters.

Time: 2 hours\*

### Project 7: Roadside Trash Pick-up (ages 18 & up only)

Don an orange safety vest (to be provided), grab a trash bag and help us pick up litter from roadsides.

Time: 4 hours\*

### Project 8: Laundry Mat/Car Wash Project

Visit and witness to patrons while they do laundry; provide quarters, washing powder and dryer sheets along with conversation.

Time: 5 hours\*

### Project 9: Car Clinic

Perform free minor auto check-ups: oil and other fluid levels, tire pressure, lights, wipers, tire tread, etc. (No actual repairs)

Time: 4 hours\*

### Project 10: Pregnancy Support Center Project

Rake leaves, pull weeds, and plant spring flowers.

Time: 3 hours\*

### Project 11: Cool Ties for Soldiers

Bring your sewing machine to the church and create special cooling neck wraps for soldiers.

Time: 4 hours\*

### Project 12: Music Team

Join your voices with other volunteers and sing to residents at local nursing facilities.

Time: 2 hours\*

### Project 13: Flower Team

Bring flowers from your yard and prepare bouquets for nursing home residents.

Time: 4 hours\*

### Project 14: Food Team

Prepare light breakfast for volunteers going out early. Feed lunches to teams working at the church and pack bag lunches for other teams.

Time: 6 – 8 hours\*

### Project 15: Backyard Bible School

Conduct Bible School activities for children at a community location.

Time: 4 hours\*

### Project 16: Children's Team

Provide activities for school-age children (kindergarten – 5<sup>th</sup> grade) at the church.

Time: 6 – 8 hours\*

### Project 17: Clothes Closet

Conduct a clothes drive on April 19. Volunteers will advertise, collect, sort and deliver clothing to area agencies.

Time: all day\*

### Project 18: Book Sale

Conduct used book sale at the church. Money to go to local missions.

Time: all day\*

\*Notes: Times given for projects are estimates of time needed to complete the projects. You may volunteer to work for part of the project time if you are unavailable for the entire time.
