Bison Ranch Retreat Center

This is our third time at Bison Ranch Retreat Center. Bison Ranch is located on 170 acres between Payson and Show Low, Arizona. At 6500 feet up on the Rim, the September air is crisp and filled with the scent of the Ponderosa Pines. There are miles of nature trails in the 800,000 acres of national forestland that backs up to the property. There is plenty of free time throughout the weekend. During the day, the most popular activities are hiking, horseback riding, basketball, fishing, or just spending some quiet time alone with God. At night, there are campfires, ping-pong, billiards, and college football games on the big screen TV.

Similar to last year, you have a choice of sleeping in either the two-story lodge or the log cabins*. With either selection, you have clean beds, showers, and towels.
