**JUNIOR L(EADER) I(N) T(RAINING) PROGRAM**

**Purpose:** The intent of this program is to allow those who may wish to serve as staff at God Camp a chance to experience these roles under supervision prior to becoming eligible for the positions on an individual basis.

**Who is Eligible:** To be considered for this program a candidate needs to have completed the 8<sup>th</sup> grade, and will be moving into the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. This is a program designed for the high school aged youth.

**Duration of Program:** Potential candidates will attend a Leaders in Training (LIT) program prior to the camp session. They will then be paired with an experienced counselor and staff member as mentors for the rest of the camp session.

**Cost:** 280.00 per person (80.00 for the training days, and 200.00 for the week at camp).

**Program:** This program is designed to aid those interested in becoming a future Staff at Camp. Each individual candidate will participate and observe during standard camp sessions in the appropriate capacity. Each individual candidate's mentors will aid in the instruction of what is expected of the candidate in their respective position as well as be available for any questions or concerns that may arise for the candidate. Each individual candidate's set of mentors will also observe and provide appropriate feedback to the candidate when applicable. Upon completion of the program, each candidate will meet with the Assistant Director for Camp and discuss their experience. This discussion will also serve as a final feedback session to let each candidate know his or her strengths and areas to improve upon.

**Completion of Program:** Upon completion of the program and final feedback session, the Assistant Director will make a final evaluation of each candidate and pass that evaluation on to the Director of God Camp. This evaluation will determine whether the individual candidate is sufficiently ready to perform the desired position or if more development is needed.
