Philosophy

At Faith Nursery School we believe exposure breeds appreciation and appreciation encourages mastery and enjoyment of the many things God has given us. In the 4 yr. old program, at a preschool level, we expose children to art, music, literature, and culture—we dance like Degas' ballerinas, gaze up at Van Gogh's starry night, and paint like Jackson Pollock. We have music every day and physical education at least once a week. The class Teddy bear gets mail from famous places all over the world. Recognizing these things later on creates excitement for more receptive learning.
