From Duluth: 85 North to Lawrenceville-Suwanee Exit (#111). Turn right and go approximately 5 miles. Turn right at the light (Russell Road intersection) into the church parking lot.

From Dacula: GA 20 to Russell Road (Russell Ridge Shopping Center). Turn west on Russell Road. Stay on Russell Road until it dead ends at Lawrenceville-Suwanee Rd. Go straight through the light into church parking lot.

From Suwanee: Take Lawrenceville-Suwanee Road across I-85. Stay on Lawrenceville-Suwanee Rd. for approximately 5 miles past I-85 to Russell Rd. Turn right at the light (Russell Road intersection) into the church parking lot.

From Lawrenceville/Grayson area: Take GA 120 heading toward GA 316. Turn right onto Lawrenceville-Suwanee Rd. Go approximately 3 miles to Russell Rd. Turn left at the light (Russell Road intersection) into the church parking lot.

What is the Marriage Course?

The Marriage Course is an 8-evening course that gives any married couple (newlywed to golden anniversary, and beyond) the tools to build and maintain a healthy marriage that lasts a lifetime.
