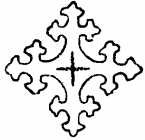

EPISCOPAL CHURCH WOMEN

- Altar Guild:** *This guild prepares the church for all services.*
- Flower Guild:** *Helps provide flowers and greenery for arrangements.*
- Bereaved Care:** *Serves light refreshments for small receptions after funeral services at family's request through clergy. Work with Trinity Bereaved Care Committee.*
- Bookstore:** *Volunteers staff the Cathedral Bookstore.*
- Casseroles:** *Prepares casseroles for Trinity members in need or at the birth of a baby.*
- Church Women United:** *Open to all women from area churches. Provides migrant worker kits.*
- Churchyard Guild:** *Helps fine tune the churchyard after the yard service has been there.*
- Docents:** *Conducts informational tours of the Cathedral and churchyard.*
- Episcopal Church Women:** *Diocesan-wide organization for Episcopal women.*
- Flower Delivery:** *Delivers altar flowers to the sick and shut-in members of the Parish. We especially need Easter delivery volunteers.*

- General Meeting of DHC:**
 - Decorations:** *Provides or helps arrange centerpieces for general meetings.*
 - Lunches:** *Prepares lunch at the four meetings; need cooks, servers, and helpers.*
- Harvest Hope Food Collection:** *Collects food for those in need.*
- Hospitality:** *Helps with preparations of special receptions as requested by the clergy and DHC Board.*
 - help with simple food help with flowers help with set-up and serving.
- Lemonade-on-the-Lawn:** *Serves lemonade to the congregation during the summer months.*
- Lenten Lunches:** *Provides desserts; helps prepare and serve lunch on Wednesdays during Lent.*
- Mailings:** *Stuffs envelopes for DHC mailings, three per year.*
- Needlework Guild:** *Meets for needlework projects.*
- Newcomers:** *Welcomes and encourages new members to participate.*
- Pastoral Care:** *Visits parishioners in the hospital – training available.*
- Seeds of Hope Farmers Market:** *Helps farmer sell produce in our parking lot on summer Sundays.*
- St. Lawrence Place:** *Provides affordable housing & support services to homeless & low-income families.*
- Still Hopes Special Events:** *Plans parties for Valentine's Day, Ice Cream Social & Christmas Sing-Along.*
- Washington Street Soup Kitchen:** *Prepares & serves a simple meal to the homeless on Thursdays at Washington Street United Methodist Church.*
- W.A. Perry Middle School:** *Partnerships with after-school program to provide snacks & enrichment activities.*

_____ **Still Hopes:** *This chapter meets at 10:30 a.m. at Still Hopes the second Monday of each month (except during the summer). Most participants are Still Hopes residents, but everyone is welcome.*
