

\$1,000,000 CHALLENGE!

Henriette, Zyb, and Page Morris, very loyal Trinity parishioners, have offered a wonderful and generous challenge to the Bicentennial Restoration Campaign. The details are still being worked out, but the basic idea is a 3 for 1 challenge. In other words, for every three dollars (\$3) we can raise of special new money from parishioners, our donor family will give one dollar (\$1) up to \$250,000. As the math easily suggests, the goal is to raise \$1 million - \$250,000 from our wonderful donor family and \$750,000 of new money raised in response to the challenge.

The genius of this challenge is that the response money must come from parishioners who did not give to the Cornerstone Campaign for whatever reason and who have not yet given to the Bicentennial Restoration of Trinity Cathedral and Parish House Campaign.

In other words, this is an invitation and encouragement to have the whole parish participate in our important capital fundraising.

The match period began January 1, 2008. The period ends when we get \$750,000 in new dollars!
