Whether such diagnosis or treatment is rendered at the office of said physician or at said hospital.

The undersigned shall be liable and agrees to pay all costs and expenses incurred in connection with such medical and dental services rendered to the aforementioned youth pursuant to this authorization.

Should it be necessary for our (my) youth to return home due to medical reasons or otherwise, the undersigned shall resume all transportation costs.

The undersigned does also hereby give permission for our (my) child to ride in any vehicle designated by the adult in whose care the minor has been entrusted while attending and participating in activities sponsored by Trinity Episcopal Cathedral.

Trinity Cathedral' s Youth Ministry Code of Conduct

1. Everyone shall be responsible for his or her own words and actions recalling the scripture “You shall love your neighbor as yourself”.
2. Any person doing damage to another’s personal property will be required to pay for the damage in addition to being sent home.
3. There shall be no immoral conduct during any youth event.
4. There shall be no possession or use of illegal drugs or alcohol while traveling to, during, and while traveling home from youth activities. There shall be no use of illegal drugs or alcohol, by youth or adults, for activities at which youth are participants.
5. There shall be no use of motor vehicles by youth during any youth event.
6. There shall be no weapons on the person of anyone or on the grounds of any event.
7. No one is allowed to leave the grounds of any youth event. This means that everyone will participate in the activities of the event or at least be present for them. No “visitors” shall be permitted to visit with youth that are participating in an event.
8. Sleeping accommodations will be arranged so that male and female youth will be separated. Separation begins at curfew and ends at breakfast. At no time will any youth be allowed to visit the sleeping quarters of the opposite sex without the permission of the adult in charge.
9. Smoking is not allowed. We seek a smoke-free environment and therefore we do not allow smoking at youth events.

For the infraction of any part of this Code of Conduct, a youth’s parents will be called immediately and informed of the infraction. Arrangements will then be made to have the youth sent home.
