## BICENTENNIAL RESTORATION OF TRINITY CATHEDRAL AND PARISH HOUSE

*“From everyone to whom much has been given, much will be required;  
and from one to whom much has been entrusted, even more will be demanded.” Luke 12:48*

AND WE'RE OFF.....!

If you walk around the Trinity block on July 30, you'll begin to see evidence of preliminary construction work on our exciting restoration project. In the front courtyard, we will set up the staging area, which will involve some fencing to provide space for pipe, equipment and tools. This will mark the beginning of the HVAC replacement.

On the outside of the Cathedral, a new handicap ramp will be installed at the **north** Narthex. Plans are being drawn by Larry Woodrum, AIA, and work is scheduled to begin the week of August 6. Scaffolding will also be set up in the **north** Narthex for work on that tower. This part of the project should take about three weeks.

We will replace the louvers on all four sides of the tower and remove the window on the side of that **north** tower. This is one of the oldest (1843) windows in the Cathedral. It must be taken out and rebuilt in the contractor's shop and will be out of place for about 30 days. The hole will be covered with plywood.

When the window is reinstalled it will be covered with protective glazing that it does not currently have. We will also do some repair work and cleaning on the two stained glass windows which face Sumter Street in the **north** tower.

At the end of August, we plan to set up scaffolding in the **south** tower for another three-week project. There may need to be some adjustment to traffic patterns and seating habits in the church! This part of the project will include repairing the ceiling in the **south** Narthex, installing an exhaust fan to help alleviate the heat in the balcony, and rebuilding the south Narthex steps.

Work on the HVAC replacement will take place over several months. Equipment is on order and its delivery is scheduled around the Cathedral calendar, especially the wedding calendar!

The existing cooling system will be taken out after a November 17 wedding. The existing boiler will come out after several January weddings and Ash Wednesday (Feb. 6). Heads up! You may need to wear your woolies! You will be warned ahead of time! Installing the new boiler will take place during a window in the wedding schedule in February, and we will be back on line with the new heating system for choir rehearsals prior to Palm Sunday.

The replacement of the electrical feed for the Cathedral and the pipes and cooling tower, which are eyesores, will take place over the course of the HVAC project. They will be placed in a much less conspicuous location. All of this must be done in and around the new piping, new cooling system, and new boiler.

We're not forgetting the Parish House! Work on the two areas that have been identified as necessary starting points can be carried out independently of the Cathedral work. The lower floor women's bathroom and the former toilet adjacent to the acolyte robing area are targets for renovation. We hope this work will be done in August and September 2007.

We are delighted with your response so far to the Restoration Campaign. As work progresses, we believe that each of you will be eager to participate in a way that is meaningful to you and to our church. Soon, we will have descriptions of opportunities to make gifts which could be, but need not be, memorial gifts.

Thank you to our parishioners who have 'stepped up' already to this project to get us started. There is a lot more money to raise! So, thank you, in advance, to those of you who will 'step up' in the future to participate! We need every parishioner to make a thoughtful commitment.

We are carefully planning and implementing this important restoration. It is being done correctly and with utmost thought to the impact our work today will have on parishioners' worship experiences for the next 100 years!
