In the coming months, you will be hearing more about the exciting campaign for the Bicentennial Restoration of the Cathedral and Parish House. It's not too early to be considering the many ways you can make a contribution to the campaign beyond a traditional cash pledge.

### **Charitable Gift Annuity**

If you are considering a gift, but would also like the security of income derived from that contribution, a charitable gift annuity might be a good option for you. Using an unrestricted charitable gift annuity, you can make a gift to the Trinity Restoration Fund in the Foundation and receive interest that is paid to you. Georgia Hart found this method to be very advantageous to her and to her church.



“I found that it was a way to benefit Trinity while providing comfort and protection to George and me. The immediate tax deduction was an added benefit.

On the advice of the late Al Todd, a brilliant lawyer and dedicated Christian, we put \$100,000 in a pooled income fund from which we would draw quarterly interest, and Trinity would receive the principal when we died. Later, Trinity requested that this be changed to an **unrestricted charitable gift annuity** with a fixed income. I have always regarded this “sharing” as wonderfully reassuring and as my ultimate “back-up” should everything else go wrong!

In my old age it is a comfort, and I like knowing that my church will eventually receive a substantial gift from me. It is a financial arrangement that I encourage and heartily recommend!”

Although a charitable gift annuity doesn't support the short term construction and restoration, a gift annuity directed to the Trinity Restoration Fund in the Foundation in the long term can provide an endowment for maintenance of the Cathedral and Parish House.

### **IRA distributions**

If you are at least 70 ½, you may be able to exclude from gross income up to \$100,000 a year of otherwise taxable IRA distributions that are paid directly to Trinity Foundation. Although tax-free IRA distributions to Trinity Foundation can not be deducted as charitable contributions, the distributions do count toward satisfying your required minimum distribution for the year. Contact your personal tax accountant or financial planner before IRA distributions are made, as certain rules do apply. **Unrestricted cash gifts**, whether memorials or honoraria, go directly to the restoration work. **Bequests** provide long-term maintenance support for the Cathedral and Parish House if designated for that purpose.
