



BICENTENNIAL RESTORATION OF TRINITY CATHEDRAL AND PARISH HOUSE

*“From everyone to whom much has been given, much will be required;
and from one to whom much has been entrusted, even more will be demanded.” Luke 12:48*

As members of Trinity, each of us has enjoyed the opportunity to worship in a historic and sacred place. The stained glass windows, gothic dome and even the very pews project a majesty that can't be duplicated today.

However, as we all can see, the passage of many years has wrought serious consequences on the buildings. Every time you go to church you can see on the walls the water damage from leaking spires and leaks from cracked stucco. When you were in church when the HVAC system was broken, you knew that it is past its usefulness! The electrical system needs replacing. Much will be required of us to restore our sacred place!

In order to put our house of worship back in order, the TRINITY FOUNDATION COMMISSION brought to the Vestry the following motions for their review and vote:

1. After Larry Woodrum, AIA, prominent local architect, presented a synopsis of his restoration plan for the Cathedral and Parish House, the Vestry approved the motion to move forward with the concept of the Bicentennial Restoration of the Cathedral and Parish House.
2. The Vestry approved the motion on behalf of the Foundation Commission that unless otherwise specified, all gifts to the Foundation during this Restoration Project will go into the TRINITY RESTORATION FUND in the FOUNDATION. **Excess funds raised would be placed in a maintenance endowment in the Foundation to benefit the Cathedral and the Parish House.**
3. The Vestry approved the motion on behalf of the Foundation Commission the plan to dedicate the UNRESTRICTED INCOME from the Foundation to the Campaign for the period of the Restoration project to include all funds except those allocated for the administrative support of the Foundation.

UNRESTRICTED GIFTS and UNRESTRICTED INCOME will enable the Foundation to contribute \$100,000 annually to the Campaign for the duration of the Restoration.

In addition, Bud Tibshrary, our Senior Warden, called on the Vestry to commit a minimum of \$50,000 annually from the Cathedral budget to the Restoration project for the duration of the Campaign. The Vestry approved this motion.

The Foundation Commission and the Vestry need YOU. Our parishioners' financial participation is a valuable and essential element of the partnership.

As we move forward in our planning, it is important that each of you begin to consider your gift to restore the beauty of this treasure which is our historic church building. Your gift will prepare the Cathedral and Parish House for our Bicentennial in 2012 and beyond! We will be formalizing gift opportunities in the near future.

If not us, then who? If not now, when? We should feel inspired by God and by those who came before us to cherish, protect, and preserve our sacred space.
