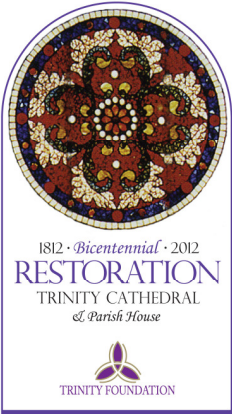

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

We are pleased to enclose in this issue of Tidings an **Honor Roll** of donors to date to the Bicentennial Restoration of Trinity Cathedral and Parish House Campaign. Members of the steering committee and the fifty solicitors who worked on the project appreciate your willingness to lead and thank you for your participation in the Campaign. This *preliminary list of donors as of September 25, 2008* represents **500 families** who have contributed **more than \$5 million to the Campaign**. We will have future versions of the list as we add names, and as folks bump up to the higher gift levels. As you have heard in the past, donors of \$5,000 and above will be listed on a plaque for the Bicentennial. However, ALL donors to the Campaign will be listed in a program that will be part of the bicentennial celebration.

Since this is only a preliminary list, we would appreciate your carefully reviewing your listing. We have made every effort to ensure the accuracy of the Honor Roll. If we have omitted or misspelled a name or attributed a gift incorrectly, we apologize and ask you to please contact Alicia Chavis (771-7300) to correct the error. It is easy to change names around at this point!

Some of you have chosen to remain anonymous. I have called most of you and either left a message or spoken directly with you. If you choose to remain anonymous, we will, of course, honor your request. However, it is encouraging to the rest of the parish when they see names of friends who have ‘stepped up’. Your gift might inspire others to follow!

I can always be reached at 799-8540 (home and voice mail) and would love to hear from you. Alicia has the ability to make changes through ACS, the church computer program used at Trinity. My only ability is to pass along your message, or simply talk about the project!

Do memorials and honoraria that you give to the Trinity Foundation ‘count’ as your gift to the Campaign? They do not count as your individual gift to the Campaign. The Foundation has a \$100,000 commitment per year for five years to the Campaign. In order to honor this commitment, we rely on gifts in memory of and in honor of family and friends. We also rely on the return on our unrestricted investments. We have been able to meet the Foundation’s commitment through your past gifts. If your name is on the Honor Roll, then you made a personal commitment through a Letter of Intent or through a cash or stock gift directed to the Campaign.

Morris Challenge

We are pleased to report the status to date of the Morris Challenge. So far, we have received over \$227,735.87 in cash that has been matched \$1 dollar for every \$3 dollars by the Morris family. That amount of \$76,000 is included in the total I mentioned above. Please remember that if you did not give to the Cornerstone Campaign to build the Trinity Center, then we are particularly interested in your gift to the Restoration Campaign because it will be matched \$1 for \$3 by the Morris Challenge.

Let us remember the Restoration in our prayers.
