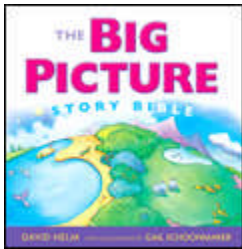


Parenting Without Perfection

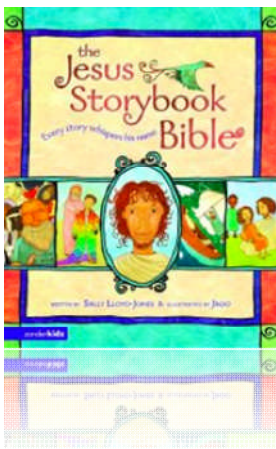

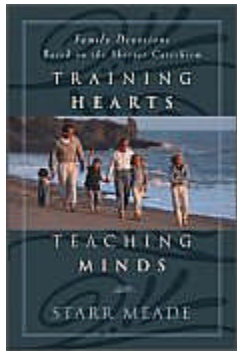
