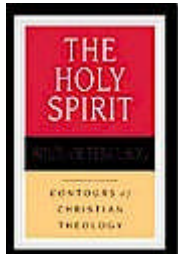


The Holiness of God

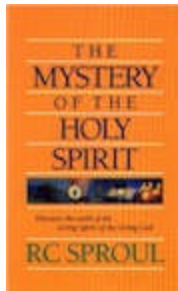


The Holy Spirit
