ADULT HOSPITALITY VOLUNTEER: Set up tables, beverages and snacks for youth prior to sessions. Monitor snack and drink service and return kitchen to clean condition at conclusion. Time commitment: Sundays 6:15-7:15 pm, 4 to 5 times per year depending on the number of volunteers.

ADULT PRESENCE SUPERVISOR Core teams that provide adult presence at Faith Formation sessions on a rotating basis. Training provided. Time commitment: 1-3 sessions on average per month from October-May for Elem. And MSYM depending on the number of volunteers; 3-4 times per year for TYM. Requires background screening and safe environment training

ADULT PRESENCE VOLUNTEER: Monitor meeting and parish facilities during Faith Formation sessions insuring youth are all in their assigned places. Training provided. Time commitment: Sundays 6:45-8:30 pm, 4 to 5 times per year depending on the number of volunteers.

CHILD CARE TEAM: Provide on-site child care for Catechists' children under the age of four during *Elementary Faith Formation* sessions. Time commitment: 2-3 times per month during Elementary Faith Formation sessions.

FAITH CATECHIST/MODERATOR: Team of two people who share the responsibilities of facilitating small peer groups of children/youth through prayer, faith sharing, and activities. Training and material provided. Time commitment: 3 sessions on average per month from October-May. Requires background screening and safe environment training. **FF Registration fee waived.**

GRADE LEVEL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR: As part of a team of people who assist the catechists, you will use craft/activity books, storybooks, videos, etc. provided by the Faith Formation office to plan activities that will enhance the lessons being taught. Can be done at home or in the Resource Room at the school. Monthly group planning sessions will be offered.

RETREAT/LOCK-IN CHAPERONES: Participate in overnight retreat and/or other overnight opportunity ensuring the safety of youth attending events. Time commitment: once or twice a year. Requires background screening and safe environment training.

TYM HOSPITALITY COORDINATOR: This person coordinates volunteers for set-up and clean-up of snacks for each session of High School Faith Formation. Time Commitment: 6:15-7:15 pm, 6 times per year.

VOLUNTEER OFFICE ASSISTANCE: Assist Faith Formation Office as needed with computer and administrative duties.
