Directions to St. Patrick, Fayetteville

from Wilmington and points Southeast of St. Patrick

Follow NC 87 north to Fayetteville. Exit at Robeson Street. Turn left onto Robeson and follow to Village Drive. Turn left onto Village Drive. Saint Patrick will be on the right after the second traffic signal.

As an alternate follow I-40 north. Exit at NC 24 and follow NC 24 west to Fayetteville. After a large railroad overpass the road will end. NC 24 is directed to the right BUT turn LEFT onto Bragg Blvd/Robeson Street. Follow Robeson to Village Drive. Turn left onto Village Drive. Saint Patrick will be on the right after the second traffic signal.

from Raleigh/Durham, and points Northwest of St. Patrick

Follow I-40 east to I-95. Follow I-95 south to Fayetteville. Use Exit 56 which is 301/Bus 95. Follow that about six miles to Grove Street (the first traffic signal). Turn right onto Grove Street which is also NC 24. Follow NC 24. After a large railroad overpass the road will end. NC 24 is directed to the right BUT turn LEFT onto Bragg Blvd/Robeson Street. Follow Robeson to Village Drive. Turn left onto Village Drive. Saint Patrick will be on the right after the second traffic signal.

from Greenville, Goldsboro and points Northeast of St. Patrick

Follow Hwy 13 to I-95. Follow I-95 south to Fayetteville. Use Exit 56 which is 301/Bus 95. Follow that about six miles to Grove Street (the first traffic signal). Turn right onto Grove Street which is also NC 24. Follow NC 24. After a large railroad overpass the road will end. NC 24 is directed to the right BUT turn LEFT onto Bragg Blvd/Robeson Street. Follow Robeson to Village Drive. Turn left onto Village Drive. Saint Patrick will be on the right after the second traffic signal.

from Lumberton and points Southwest of St. Patrick

Follow I-95 north. Exit at 301/Bus 95 (first Fayetteville exit). Follow 301/Bus 95 to Owen Drive (this is the first intersection past the Coliseum complex). Turn left onto Owen Drive. Follow Owen Drive to Village Drive. Turn right onto Village Drive. Saint Patrick will be on the left after the second traffic signal.
