STEWARDSHIP We are happy to report that, as of November 14, 253 pledges, totaling \$1,123,571, have been returned. Over half of the pledges returned so far have indicated an increase over 2016 and many have been for 10% or more. We are off to a great start, but we are well short of our goal of \$1,450,000 in pledged income for 2017. Pledged income is the church's most reliable and largest by far revenue source and if we do not reach our goal of \$1,450,000, the Session will have to make corresponding and painful cuts in proposed expenditures for 2017.
