At 11:00 ushers will invite you to come forward by row. Break off a generous piece of bread, dip it in the cup, and then partake. Gluten-free crackers are available at each station.

Jesus chose not to go easy on the "religious" people of his day. He called for more than just the practice of traditional religious rituals. He asked us to discover places in our hearts to carry out God's commandments.

In the early church, Christians brought to worship gifts of bread and wine from their own tables. During the service, deacons would set apart the amount of bread and wine needed for the Lord's Supper. At the completion of the service, church officers distributed whatever bread and wine had not been blessed at the Table to hungry people in the community.
