




Building community among young families...



Welcoming Your Child

When your family welcomes a new child into your home we want to share that joyful news.

We will share information about the birth or adoption as well as place a rose in the sanctuary in honor of your child. Please supply the following information to the New Baby Team when you are contacted or send to the church office.

Full Name
Date of Birth and/or adoption
Name of Parents

The New Baby Team will also provide a gift Bible and a cradle cross for your child. Someone from the New Baby Team will deliver these items to your home.



Listed below are a series of services that are available to you. Someone from the Team will be in touch to find out how we can best support your family.

Temporary Needs:

- **Meal Support**

We will provide a meal or meals for your family during this time of transition. If you would like to take advantage of this please contact Holly Moton at hollymoton@bellsouth.net and she will schedule times to deliver meals. She or someone else from our Team may also contact you to see if you are interested in having a meal delivered.



- **Pastoral Visit**

One of our pastors would enjoy visiting you at the hospital after your child is born or at your house after you welcome your child home. If you will let the church office (704-892-5641 or rboggs@dcpc.org) or one of the pastors know what is best for you we can schedule the best time for a visit.

- **Transportation Ministry**

If you are in need of transportation for a doctor appointment or to run errands to the grocery or pharmacy you may contact Judy McLean at judyclean@mi-connection.com.

- **Stephen Ministry**

The experience of having children can be both joyful and exhausting. It can be a challenging experience! Our Stephen Ministers receive extensive training to walk alongside those who are going through such times.



Whether you are struggling emotionally, physically, or spiritually due to some loss or change in your life, Stephen Ministry may be for you. A Stephen Minister can be assigned to you for whatever time frame is helpful to you. The relationship remains confidential. Ongoing Needs for your child:

- **Baptism**

Baptism is a sacrament of the church that reminds of God's never-ending love and grace for us. Through baptism we celebrate our place in the family of faith and our new life in Christ. - **Nursery Care**

Our church nursery is located in room 12 on the first floor and is open Sunday 15 minutes prior to services. This space is reserved for children age 0-2 so you will find a safe and child-friendly environment. There is an adjacent crib room with plenty of fresh linens available. The nursery staff consists of employees as well as volunteers, with a minimum of two adults present at all times. We are a nut-free childcare facility and copies of our child protection policy may be found on the church website (Under Learn/Children). It is an honor and delight to have babies in the nursery. We hope you'll join us soon!

- **DCPC Preschool**
