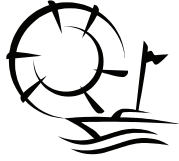
### **Let's continue our spring cleaning ...**

## SING, CHILDREN! SING!

It's a new season for children's choirs, and plans are in progress for ALL our children to sing in worship during the Easter season. And our pre-school children, the Promise Choir, will provide a beautiful and precious moment in our Easter Sunday, April 12, 11 a.m. service.

Have your children been coming to choir, but perhaps got out of the habit over the holidays? If so, it's time to *get in gear and come back to choir!* Haven't been in choir before? You don't know what you've been missing! Give it a try; you'll be glad you did.

### "Promise Choir" (Pre-School)

Making music together can play a very important role in healthy child development. And that's what our pre-school choir program is about – having fun learning about and making music together, play, developing friendships with other children of the church, all within a Biblical, spiritual context. The Promise Choir is directed by our wonderful ECU student Music Intern, Jessica Laliberte.
