1. One box of Crayola “classic” primary colored, **Washable Markers**.  
(Crayola Brand- red, blue, yellow, green, orange, purple brown and black.)
2. One box of Crayola crayons – 8 count large primary size.(Same colors as above)
3. Four Elmer’s white glue sticks
4. One ream of color copy paper
5. One box of Quart size freezer bags
