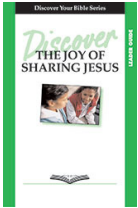

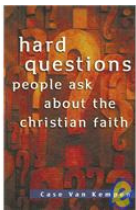

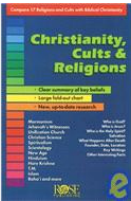


Hard Questions People Ask About the Christian Faith

- Do I need to go to church to get to heaven?

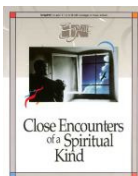


Christianity, Cults, and Religions

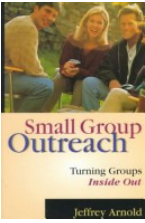

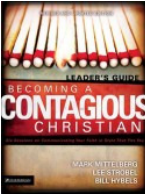

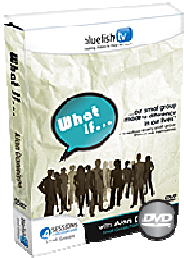
