GUIDELINES and SUGGESTIONS FOR QUILTS and HANDMADE ITEMS

The Quilt Committee would like you to look over the following information and consider a donation to the auction. We appreciate your response to last year's auction and are looking forward to a great participation in 2017.

Quilts, miniature quilts, and wall hangings should be hand or machine pieced, hand appliquéd, made of 100% cotton or cotton blends, and pre-washed before piecing.

1. Quilts

- a. Machine or hand pieced, hand appliquéd, or whole cloth
- b. To be considered a quilt, it should be hand or machine quilted.
(Tops that are knotted are considered comforters.)

c. Approximate Sizes:

Crib	45" X 54"	Queen	92" X 108"
Twin	72" X 95"	King	115" X 115"
Double	90" X 108"

4. Old quilts and parts of damaged quilts can be used for other handcrafted projects. Please get these to a committee member to be used in items for 2018 auction.

5. Bedspreads – crocheted (include pattern names)

6. Tablecloths – crocheted (include pattern names)

7. Afghans – crocheted (include pattern names)

8. Comforters

9. Identify the size, pattern and person or church group making the above and attach to item with a pin.

10. Pieced or Appliqued tops - clean your closets or cedar chest and find a top or unfinished squares to make a quilt, the committee would be happy to see what they can do with them

11. Scrap pieces - we will use or sell these if you would like to donate, please bring to auction

NOTE: All items are to be clean, free of stains, lint, dust, animal hair and odor. Check each item carefully before donating.

We have been wrapping our quilts for the auction in clear plastic to protect them from odors, dirty fingers, and oils. A lot of work and expense goes into making a quilt. We want to present it the best we can. We know they don't always bring the prices they should at the auction, but if we make them in good faith, it is our best and pleasing to the Lord.

Please get quilts and wall hangings to Helen Shank or Becky Lane prior to May 1st so they can be wrapped and information included in the quilt brochure at the auction.
