

Wheelchair-accessible parking at Park Street Church

- Driving and parking downtown can certainly be stressful, especially if you have never been here before. We are excited to have you come join us and want to have you here; but there is little we can do to fix the streets! We have provided the information below to help make driving and parking as easy as possible. We do recommend allowing yourself extra time if you can do so.
- In terms of actual street parking, there are several handicapped parking spots right on Park Street. As you drive up Park Street so that you pass the church building on your right, the spots are along the sidewalk just a little further up. If you take a right onto Beacon Street at the top of the hill, you can take your second left onto Somerset Street, and there are handicapped parking spots on either side of the street there. However, some of them are only reserved for handicapped parking during the workweek, so you may see that other people are parked there. If you then take another left onto Ashburton Place, there are 4 handicapped parking spaces on the left side of the street there. If you stay on Beacon Street rather than turning onto Somerset Street, there are also a few handicapped parking spots there.
- Another option is parking in the One Beacon Street garage. To get to the One Beacon Street garage, you need to drive up Tremont Street, pass the Government center T stop on your left, and turn right shortly after that. The garage has an elevator to bring you up to street level and push buttons to open doors, as well as a ramp to exit the building. Parking can be validated at the church (reduced cost of \$7); please inquire at the desk in the Ockenga lobby for assistance with validation.

- Park Street Church is easily located at the intersection of the redline and the greenline at the Park Street stop. An elevator and mobile lift are available. Check www.mbta.com and click “accessible services” for more information.

Access into Park Street Church

- Our ramp is at the entrance on the Park Street side of the building. As of this writing, there is not a push button to open the door independently. We apologize for this ahead of time!
- Once you have entered the church, turn to your right and go through the back of the welcome center. The library will be on your right. Straight ahead of you is the elevator. The sanctuary is on level 2; the main floor and welcome center are on level 1, and the Fellowship Hall is on level B.
- In the sanctuary, there are several spots both on the left and right sections of pews that have spaces for wheelchairs.
