Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT IS BEING BUILT?

A state-of-the art, 45,000 square foot school to accommodate today's enrollment and future growth. The school will contain 22 classrooms, dedicated art, science and computer labs, as well as a library and gymnasium.

WHY NOW?

Congregation Beth El has sold the building so we need a new home. This is a wonderful opportunity to create our own facility that reflects our long standing tradition of high quality secular and Jewish education.

WHEN WILL IT BE READY?

The school is scheduled to be open for school year 2008-2009.

HOW MUCH NEEDS TO BE RAISED?

Our goal is \$11 million and we are happy to report we have already raised more than \$8.6 million.

WHAT CAN I DO?

Kellman Academy needs the help of all families to make gifts large and small. We ask that you consider a pledge that is meaningful to you and reflects your commitment to your child's education. This is different for each family. EVERY gift is important. If everyone gives a gift that makes them feel good, the goal will be reached.

DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR THIS IMMEDIATELY?

No. This pledge is payable over 5 years. A pledge of \$10,000 is \$2,000 a year for 5 years. A pledge of \$25,000 is \$5,000 a year and so on.

IS THAT IT?

With your gift of \$3,600 or more you have the opportunity to dedicate a room, a wing or some area of the building that may be meaningful to you. (Please refer to the dedication opportunities page.) Gifts of \$10,000 or more will be permanently acknowledged on a beautiful Donor Wall that will adorn the central lobby of the school. Those families that have given to capital campaigns in the past will be recognized in an appropriate fashion to acknowledge their generosity as early builders and supporters of Kellman Academy.
