PHILOSOPHY  
& CURRICULUM

From birth through seven years of age, your child can grow with Kindermusik without pressure to perform, only encouragement to explore, express and discover. Kindermusik's age-appropriate musical activities encourage a developmental evolution in language skills, literacy, listening, problem solving, social skills, self-esteem and musicality!

**Kindermusik Adventures** are 5-class sessions, with theme-based activities appropriate to each age. Children in Village (newborn-18mo) and Our Time (18mo-3yrs) classes attend with their parent/guardian, as the Kindermusik philosophy recognizes that every parent is the child's most important teacher. Children in Imagine That! (3-5yrs) and Young Child (5-7yrs) attend without parents, except for the last 15 minutes of each class where parents are invited to recap the day's activities. As Kindermusik recognizes that the best early learning takes place in the home, each child is provided with wonderful home materials designed for their age to enable continued exploration outside class. Our summer session will feature 2 rotating curriculums for each age group, so a child may attend more than one session and have a whole different set of activities, materials and fun!

VILLAGE (newborn to 18mo)  
5 classes, 60 min. each

Each class includes instrument exploration and snack times; Parent attends with child.

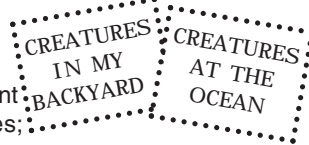


**PEEKABOO! I LOVE YOU!** (Sessions 1, 3 & 5) features music and more ways to say "I love you" using American Sign Language, soap bubbles, blue-star sponges, and parent-baby dances. Home materials include a CD, baby book, parent poster & softest-ever star sponge & "ducky mirror."

**BUSY DAYS** (Sessions 2 & 4) features activities and songs you can sing for all the places you go together—the store, the playground, the doctor, and more. Home materials include a CD, baby book, parent poster & cage bell.

OUR TIME (18mo to 3yrs)  
5 classes, 60 min. each

Each class includes instrument exploration and snack times; Parent attends with child.



**CREATURES IN MY BACKYARD**

(Sessions 1, 3 & 5) gives a child something to sing about in her own backyard--be the flower from the seed's perspective; run and jump in hula hoop rain puddles, etc. Home materials include a CD, picture-folders & plush bunny hand puppet.

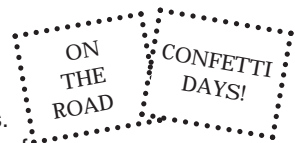
**CREATURES AT THE OCEAN** (Sessions 2 & 4) features sailor songs and ocean-themed musical fun and games! Home materials include a CD, picture-folders, story cards & seashell handle castanets.

FAMILY FUN (newborn to 4 yrs)--5 classes, 60 min. each  
Features the same curriculum as OUR TIME sessions, with adaptations for parents with more than one child in class, considering different ages and developmental stages. Home materials for additional children include all except CD.

IMAGINE THAT! (3 to 5yrs)  
5 classes, 1.5hrs. each

Each class includes instrument exploration, snack & craft times.

Parents attend last 15 minutes of class. Children must be fully potty-trained!



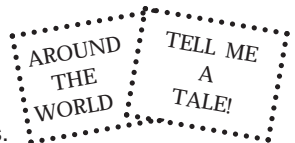
**ON THE ROAD** (Sessions 1, 3 & 5) features songs and games likely to revive a memory from summers past--Eye Spy, finding shapes in the clouds, etc., & imaginative trips in a bus named "Van Go." Home materials include a CD, poster, hard-cover book and a wooden frog guiro instrument.

**CONFETTI DAYS!** (Sessions 2 & 4) features party songs & game--riding a carousel inside the classroom, balancing on the "web of ropes," learning colors and singing "De Colores" & other party songs. Home materials include a CD, picture folders, story kit & a pair of confetti bells.

YOUNG CHILD (5 to 7yrs)  
5 classes, 2hrs. each

Each class includes instrument exploration, snack & craft times.

Parents attend last 15 minutes of class.



**AROUND THE WORLD** (Sessions 1, 3 & 5) Visit a new country each lesson (Germany, Japan, Africa, England, and Mexico) through native songs, instruments & games. Home materials include a CD, picture folders, parent brochure & arts & crafts materials.

**TELL ME A TALE** (Sessions 2 & 4) features tales from around the world (Europe, Malaysia, South Africa, India & Appalachia) explored through multi-instrument and multi-cultural elements. Home materials include a CD, book, parent poster and lummi sticks.
