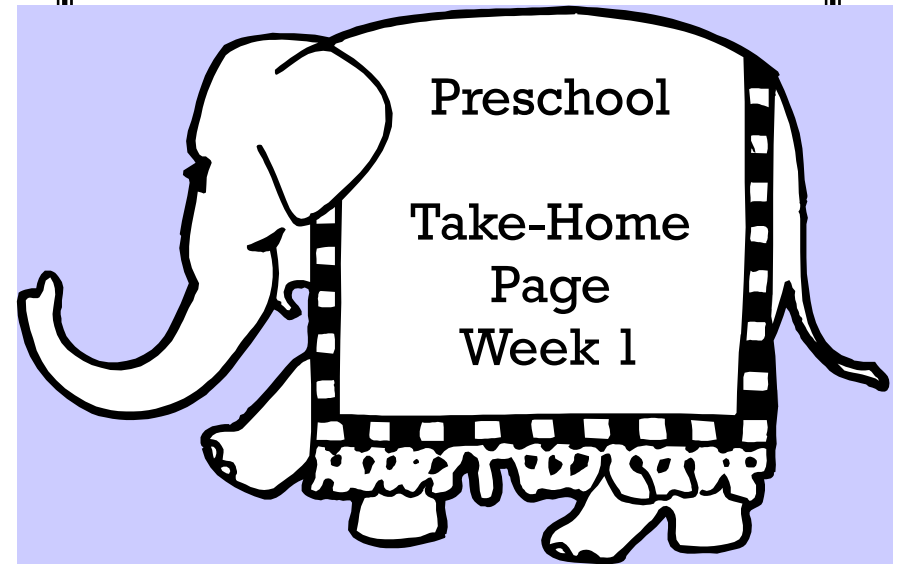


Family Activities

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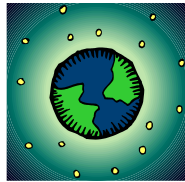

God Created the World

Close your eyes. What do you see? At first that is all there was, just dark and empty. God said, "Let there be light," and He made day and night. That was the first day of creation. On the second day God made the sky. On the third day, He separated the ocean from the land and made trees and plants to grow on the land. Then God made the sun, the moon, and the stars on the fourth day. Next He made the creatures that live in the sea and the birds that fly in the sky. That was the fifth day. On day six, God made the animals that live on the land, and He made people. God saw all that He had made, and it was good. And on the seventh day, God rested.

When God made the first person, Adam, He put him in a special garden He had made. It was called the Garden of Eden. God gave Adam the job of giving names to all of the animals. God brought each kind of animal to Adam, and whatever Adam called it, that became its name. God knew that Adam needed someone to help him, so He created a woman, Eve. Adam and Eve lived in the Garden of Eden and took care of the things God had made.
