Disaster Relief Chaplains extend the witness and care of the church into a very specialized time of ministry in the lives of people disrupted unexpectedly by a disaster. For this reason, the training requirements for endorsement as a Disaster Relief Chaplain are set high.

The Disaster Relief Chaplain is a volunteer and must meet these requirements:

- Complete the training "Involving Southern Baptists in Disaster Relief" (about 2 hours).
- Complete the training "Southern Baptist Disaster Relief Chaplains Manual" (about 9 hours).
- Complete one unit of training in either Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) (about 16 hours) or National Organization for Victim Assistance (NOVA) (about 40 hours).

The training is coordinated and scheduled by the Southern Baptist state convention of each state through the office of the Disaster Relief Director or State Chaplaincy Representative.
