A PARENT'S PRIORITY IS TO GRADUALLY TRANSFER A CHILD'S DEPENDENCE
AWAY FROM THEM UNTIL IT RESTS SOLELY ON GOD

1. Have a three generation VISION

"These are the commands, decrees and laws the LORD your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess, so that you, your children and their children after them may fear the LORD your God as long as you live." Deuteronomy 6:1-2

2. Love your GOD

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." Deuteronomy 6:4-5

Kids Who Become Active Christ-followers as Adults

If mom and dad went to church: 72% of kids will as adults

If only mom went to church: 15% of kids will as adults

If only dad went to church: 55% of kids will as adults

If neither mom or dad: 6% of kids will as adults

3. Lead your FAMILY

"These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children.
