PROPOSED DATES:

November 14-19, leave Sunday afternoon and return Saturday.

This is the week before Thanksgiving. Many of the Christmas decorations will be up, but most of the Christmas shows do not begin until after Thanksgiving. Sounds like great timing.

HOTEL:

Disney All Star Music Resort with 5 Days of park entrances. (It is only \$3, yes three dollars, cheaper to buy four days of tickets). To stay on Disney property and buy the ticket package gets a quick service eating plan. That includes daily two meals, two snacks and a free refill mug at the hotel.

PRICE:

The price will be under \$600 per person, double occupancy. (That means you need two people per room for that price) That includes hotel, 10 meals (2 each day), 10 snacks (2 each day), refill mug, 5 days of entrance into the park, free transportation to and from the parks, a group professional pastoral Disney guide, gas for the bus and a little cushion in case I added wrong! FEEDING THE POOR: JAMES ISLAND OUTREACH

The James Island Ministerial Association, led by the Board of James Island Outreach, has done an excellent job in recasting the vision for helping the poor on James Island/Folly Beach. They took a survey that indicated a desire to open J.I. Outreach more hours, to expand services and to continue to share Christ in appropriate ways. The new hours will begin in September and will include training for those who would like training. Each participating church family is responsible for a team to cover one of the opening times. James Island Baptist will be responsible for the 3rd Saturday of each month. We already have one team of ladies who are willing to cover this time. If you would like to participate, there are other hours still available on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. A class could volunteer to cover a time or be available to sub for a team. Basically, each team will consist of someone to bag the needed groceries, someone who will receive and stock donated items, a greeter and someone to enter data in Charity Tracker.
