## How to use the Billy Graham Prayer Card



Prayer is powerful. It says in James 5:13-20 if there is a need, a praise, or a lost soul we should pray. If this is what we should do, then why do we often forget to follow that which God laid out for us to do in scripture concerning prayer?

On the right, you will see how we encourage you to use the Billy Graham Prayer Card. The purpose of this card is three-fold. Its first purpose is to be a resource available to churches in order to help support their prayer ministry. Its second purpose is to help guide individuals in those churches to seek out other believers so that they can begin to pray together for their church, pastor, and America. The third purpose, and maybe its most important, is to encourage specific prayer for the lost people living in your community.

Our hope is that once you begin praying for the lost members of your community you will develop a passion to see them come to know the Lord. Our prayer is that God will radically move in your church and in the lives of your congregation. May there be no more room left on the pews and no available chairs because those in need and those that are lost are filling them.

**SO LET'S BEGIN...**

**Prepare yourself to pray.**

Read Psalm 139:23-24; 1John 1:9. Confess your sins to the Lord and give the Lord a clean vessel with which to work.

**Choose two prayer partners to pray with you.**

(See Ecclesiastes 4:12; Matthew 18:19-20)

**Pray together.**

1. Agree on a time to meet regularly. It doesn't have to be a long time, just a consistent one.
2. Share with God, and each other, any personal needs for cleansing and spiritual readiness, and pray specifically for each other. If we regard iniquity in our hearts, God will not hear us.
3. Share the names of those who are lost. These nine names should be kept confidential to your group.
4. Pray for the lost on your cards:
  - a. That they will be enlightened (Acts 26:18; 1Cor. 2:14; 2 Cor. 4:4).
  - b. That they will be loosed (2 Tim. 2:25-26).
  - c. That they will be saved (Rom. 10:1, 1 Tim. 2:1-4).
5. Pray for yourself for boldness. Pray for tears (Ps. 126:5-6).
6. Pray to the Lord for laborers (Matt. 9:35-38)
