From Your Director of Missions...

Last June, the messengers at the Southern Baptist Convention approved the report from The Great Commission Resurgence Task Force. No one was completely sure how this would all work out but we knew that at the very least it would change how the North American Mission Board (NAMB) and the International Mission Board (IMB) would operate. Last month, August, I attended a meeting at White Oak Conference Center to "discuss" what the changes would mean to the South Carolina Baptist Convention and to local associations. It was called a "GCR (Great Commission Resurgence) Discussion." It was attended by about 600 people, many of them from the Chesterfield Baptist Association. It started at about 10:00 a.m. and lasted until about 4:00 p.m. There were statistics, sermons, and small group breakouts. **My take-a-way** from this is that we are still unsure what changes will take place, how they will be implemented and what they will look like. **My second take-away** from this: encourage our Chesterfield Baptist Association churches to do Kingdom Business, love God, love people, win the lost, support missions, and be Christ-like in all we do. I want to encourage all of our Pastors and as many lay people as possible to attend the meeting of the South Carolina Baptist Convention next November. It should be an interesting convention.
