COVID-19 WORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

As Grace Baptist Church continues to navigate through these unusual days of the Covid-19 crisis, we are re-gathering by providing several options for Sunday Worship at 9:30 am. Everyone is asked to uphold the following guidelines and restrictions.

1. **WORSHIP INSIDE THE CLC**
 - Participate in physical distancing (no physical contact) and encouraged to practice good hygiene by covering your cough or sneeze and washing your hands thoroughly.
 - Masks are welcome but are not required.
 - Sit with your household, chairs will be grouped for families to sit together with appropriate distance between groups.
 - Children, of all ages, are welcome in the CLC for worship. Childcare or other age-related activities have not resumed.
 - Offering plates will be provided upon entry & exit and will not be passed during worship.
 - Worship inside the CLC is for those who are comfortable meeting in person.
2. **WORSHIP INSIDE THE WORSHIP CENTER (Old Sanctuary) - Worship via live video stream**
 - **MASKS ARE REQUIRED**
 - **STRICT PHYSICAL DISTANCING REQUIRED** - Families will sit together with appropriate distance between families. Everyone encouraged to practice good hygiene by covering their cough or sneeze and washing their hands thoroughly.
 - Offering plates will be provided upon entry & exit and will not be passed during worship.
 - Worship inside the Worship Center is for those who are potentially more vulnerable.
3. **DRIVE-IN WORSHIP** - For those who are uncomfortable with meeting in person, an audio broadcast of worship from the CLC will be broadcast via the FM transmitter in the parking lot on 88.3 FM. Men with our Safety Team will be by the exits with baskets to receive your offering as you leave the parking lot.
