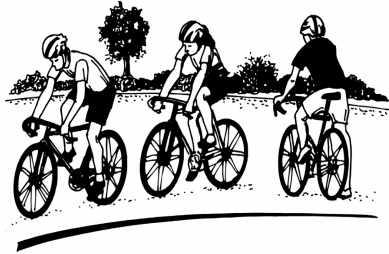


DON'T BE A DUD...BUY A SPUD!!

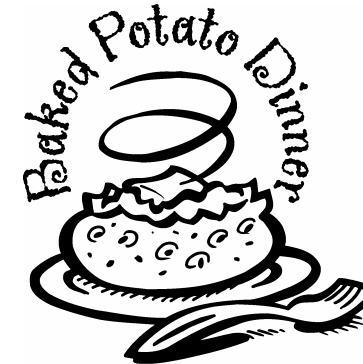
