Tucking away a "Jesus" film and a few Bibles, Zahra boarded a bus in Tehran to share the gospel with relatives in the Iranian countryside. Zahra took a risk by carrying these materials in the Islamic Republic of Iran. Publishing and distributing Bibles is illegal. Becoming a Christian and sharing the gospel can be punishable by prison or death. Despite the risks, Zahra acted to reach people in her tribe. The Lord gave Zahra boldness when the movie being shown on the bus malfunctioned. She handed the "Jesus" film to the driver, who played it all the way through. Eight of the forty people on the bus became interested in knowing more about Jesus. Giving to our Foreign Missions Offering enables personnel to share the gospel with Iranians and people in other countries. Keep this matter in your prayers during this Season of Prayer for Foreign Missions.

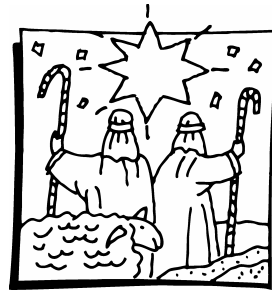
### "YOU ARE A BLESSING THANKSGIVING MEAL"

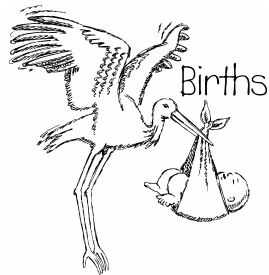
