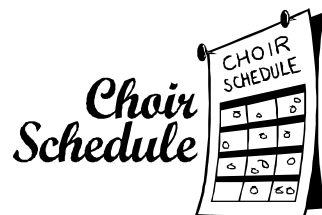


GROUP FITNESS BEGINS NEW SESSIONS
