From the Pastor

Jesse Powers mentioned a book on prayer called *Rees Howells, Intercessor*. I immediately went to LifeWay to order a copy. It is a remarkable book about a remarkable man.

Howells lived in Wales from his birth in 1879 to his death in 1950. He was a man who was totally given to prayer. After working all day in a Welsh coal mine, he would go home and spend two hours in prayer.

I remember Jesse differentiated between the two terms prayer warriors and intercessors. He evidently got his definition from this book. Howells said, "A prayer warrior can pray for a thing to be done without necessarily waiting for an answer. But an intercessor is responsible to gain his objective, and he can never be free till he has gained it."

In other words, the intercessor is intimately involved and inextricably linked to the object of the prayer. This gives more evidence of how precious Jesus is because scripture tells us He always intercedes for us.

If we could realize the significance of Jesus interceding on our behalf, it would revolutionize our prayer life.

From the Minister of Students

Have you noticed? I was walking to the youth house Sunday night and noticed a traffic jam in the church parking lot. It was great to see so many people attending on Sunday night. The pastor and I could account for about 145 people in attendance from adults and youth, not including the children's department. 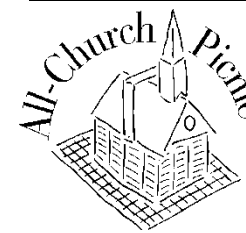
CHILDREN'S DEPARTMENT
