**Baking Mix Rolls

- 2 cups biscuit baking mix (Bisquick)
- 1 cup sour cream or lowfat plain yogurt

1/2 cup butter, melted

Combine ingredients; stir until moistened. Drop 1 tablespoon mixture into regular muffin tines of 1 to 2 teaspoons if using mini muffin tines. Bake in preheated 400 degree oven for 15 minutes or until lightly browned. Makes approximately 20 regular rolls or 35 mini rolls. Each regular roll contains 86 calories.
