During the month of November, I will lead a study of the Lord's Prayer on Sunday nights. I will be teaching a book titled *The Prayer of Jesus* by Ken Hemphill.

The Lord's Prayer has always been an enigma to many people. Sometimes we pray the prayer in unison; sometimes we see it simply as a guide. After all, Jesus seemed to utter these words as a model prayer for His disciples.

It has become a model prayer for all of us. We have dissected the prayer into its various sections, and we usually include the sections in most of our prayers, or at the framework of the prayer.

Someone has come up with the acronym ACTS to apply to this prayer; namely, adoration, confessions, thanksgiving, and supplication. These themes are present in this prayer, and we usually incorporate these themes into our praying.
