FROM THE PASTOR

I have seen the word “postmodernity” tossed around in various books that I have read. It basically serves as a label to describe our present world.

While in Columbia last week, I bought a new book written by Al Mohler, the president of my alma mater, Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

In the book, Dr. Mohler describes the “postmodern” world:

“Postmodernism rejects the very notion of truth as fixed, universal, objective, or absolute. Christian tradition understands truth as established by God and known to us through the self-revelation of God in Scripture. Instead, postmodernists argue that truth is relative, plural, and inaccessible to universal reason. Truth, to the postmodern mind, is not universal, for every culture establishes its own truth. Nor is truth objectively real, for all truth is merely constructed. In other words, it is made, not found.”

In other words, we face a generation that sees God’s Word as irrelevant or one that interprets it in the way they want. Yet, we have the command to preach truth. Jesus said He was the truth, God’s word is the truth, and the truth will set us free. Being faithful to God’s truth is our assignment.
