FROM THE PASTOR

The Bible makes it clear that we are saved by grace through faith (Eph. 2:8-9), but we must remember that even our exercise of believing is a gift of grace. Salvation is all God's doing.

I have been reading Charles Hodge's *Systematic Theology*. Hodge was a nineteenth-century Princeton theologian. Almost all of the early Southern Baptist's scholars were trained there, and his books were the standard text of seminary students for decades. Notice how he drives home the point of salvations as God's gift:

"The fact that we are saved by grace proves that the ground of salvation is not ourselves. We are saved "by" faith by receiving and resting upon Christ alone for salvation. It is Christ, His righteousness, his obedience, the merit of His blood or death. We look to him. We flee to Him. We hide ourselves in Him. We are clothed in His righteousness."

Salvation is a free gift. We simply have to receive the gift as we receive a birthday gift....gratefully.
