## FROM THE PASTOR

The Nike people have as their slogan, “just do it.” Many times we are afraid that we can’t do it, that our skills and gifts are either too meager or non-existent.

Last week I read an excellent book by David Jeremiah called, “*Signs of Life.*” He talks about this problem of ours and relates it to the biblical example of reaping and sowing. He says: “Strength, attitude, desire, and skills we think we lack before we will be able to serve are often found in the act of serving. Just as one kernel of corn can produce a corn stalk with hundreds of new kernels on multiple ears, so one single act of service to others can pay back bountiful blessings in the life of one who serves.”

In other words, we can become immobilized with a fistful of corn in our hands, not thinking that we have the skills to plant corn; or, we can release the corn and watch it grow and multiply.

When God gives us a job to do, jump into the arena of ministry; and it just might be that you have the skills and gifts that are needed. God would never give you a job that you can’t do with His help; it might be His way to bring out a gift that you thought you never had.
