FROM THE PASTOR

In Sunday’s sermon, I referred to Bill Bennett’s book, *Our Sacred Honor* as an excellent book to read. Bennett simply prints the speeches and letters that were written by our Founding Fathers.

Revisionist historians have tried to paint the Founding Fathers as a group of Deists, who see God as remote and detached, or as a group of near agnostics. While there were some notable exceptions, principally Thomas Paine, almost all of these men were not only believers, but committed Christians who were not shy about their faith. Whenever you read someone’s correspondence to another person, you see the real person. In this book, Bennett lets the writings of our Founding Fathers speak for themselves.

To get a real appreciation of the faith of America’s early leaders, I urge you to read Dr. Bennett’s book. It is reassuring and comforting to find such faith among our nations’ early political leaders.
