

Women on Mission Options

Meeting suggestions for these options are found in the Features section of *Missions Mosaic*:

Missionary Focus - Provides information about current Southern Baptist missionaries and their ministries. Groups participate in an in-depth study each month. They also pray for missions, and do mission action and witnessing projects. Groups using this option will want to invite others to join them for the International Missions Emphasis and the North American Missions Emphasis.

Prayer - Provides women with the opportunity to learn more about prayer and to experience God's power as they listen to His voice, and engage in intercessory prayer for missionaries, for people who need Christ, and for one another.

Bible Study - Provides an inductive approach to Bible learning through a monthly or weekly Bible study group. This option is a good choice for women interested in spiritual development, or women who meet together because they have common interests.

Ministry/Witness - For women who want hands-on mission action projects. Groups may choose to be involved in an on-going project or may choose various projects. Also for women who want to share their faith more effectively. Witnessing training is provided through participation in this option.

Round Table Discussion Group - For women who enjoy reading and discussing current books. Groups can choose to review the featured book or study the book together. Books may be purchased through WMU, SBC Customer Service, 1-800-968-7301. Selections include a variety of topics that encourage spiritual growth and reaching the world for Christ.

Individual Participation - Women who cannot participate in a group are still encouraged to be a part of Women on Mission by subscribing to and reading *Missions Mosaic*.
