

Mission Friends Lead Teacher Responsibilities

The Mission Friends lead teacher is responsible to the church and the Mission Friends coordinator or the WMU director (if there is no Mission Friends coordinator) for planning, conducting, and evaluating the missions program for preschoolers in her class.

Specific responsibilities include:

Promote missions involvement for preschoolers.

- Be knowledgeable about Mission Friends and model a missions lifestyle.
- Identify needs of members and prospects and maintain contact with their parents or caregivers through home visits, phone calls, and cards.
- Seek to involve all preschoolers in the church in Mission Friends.

Lead in planning, conducting, and evaluating the work of the Mission Friends class.

- Work with the teachers to set goals and implement action plans for the class. Report the progress of Mission Friends work to the Mission Friends coordinator or WMU director.
- Lead missions learning experiences. During the Mission Friends session, lead an interest area. Lead the large group time for others and older preschoolers. Involve fours through kindergarten in Helping Others activities.
- Work with teachers to plan and make assignments for missions learning experiences, contact parents of prospects and absentees, and provide resources.
- Maintain records.
- Serve on the Mission Friends Planning Team.
