Member

1. Create a missions vision by:
 - recognizing your status in Christ
 - finding an entry point to fulfill Christ's purpose in your life
 - reflecting the highest ideals of Christian living
 - seeing your life as set apart for the gospel
 - affirming God's call both individually and corporately
 - reaching beyond yourself to a global vision
 - committing to a missions lifestyle
2. Volunteer to help in your Women on Mission group
3. Subscribe to *Missions Mosaic*

Facilitator

1. Be knowledgeable about Women on Mission
 - Attend training
 - Study *How to Involve Adults in Missions*
 - Review often.
 - Read *Missions Mosaic* and *Leader Helps and Handouts* or *Women on Mission Resource Kit: Posters Plus*
 - Leadership articles
 - Plans for your group
2. Promote involvement in missions
 - Model a missions lifestyle
 - Help others see their potential in missions
3. Lead the group in planning, conducting, and evaluating the work of the group
 - Provide training for group members
 - Help develop potential leaders
 - Provide resources, especially *Missions Mosaic*
 - Teach leaders within the group how to use the planning portions of *LHH* or *Posters Plus*
 - Lead the group to develop a purpose statement, objectives and goals
 - Lead the group to develop a covenant based on the purpose, objectives and goals
 - Recognize your role as an equipper

Help the group to make plans to promote the work of the group, provide new ways to be involved in missions, and enroll new members

Keep records of group membership and activities

Develop, enlist, and equip project leaders as needed

4. Serve on the Women on Mission planning team
 - Represent your group on the team
 - Network with other groups to accomplish missions

Coordinator

1. Be knowledgeable about Women on Mission
 - Attend training
 - Study *How to Involve Adults in Missions*
 - Review often
 - Read *Missions Mosaic* and *Leader Helps and Handouts* or *Women on Mission Resource Kit: Posters Plus*
 - Leadership articles
2. Promote involvement in missions
 - Model a missions lifestyle
 - Help others see their potential in missions
 - Seek to involve all women in the church in Women on Mission
 - Help to develop new groups and opportunities for missions development
 - Coordinate training and nurturing of Women on Mission members and leaders
3. Lead in planning, conducting, and evaluating the work of Women on Mission
 - Lead the Women on Mission planning team to:
 - Identify objectives, set goals, including those for qualitative and quantitative growth, and implement action plans
 - Maintain records
 - Provide resources for groups
 - Serve on the WMU Leadership team
 - Enlist and train facilitators and project leaders
 - Prepare Women on Mission budget

Project Leader

1. If you are leading a project for one Women on Mission group, work with the facilitator of the group as you lead in planning, conducting, and evaluating the project.
2. If you are leading a project that involves more than one Women on Mission group, work with the Coordinator as you lead in planning, conducting and evaluating the project.
3. Involve others in the project

Other Leaders

Work with the facilitator of your group to carry out the plans and projects of your group.

myMISSION Leader for individually involved members

1. Maintain a list of women individually involved in myMISSION
2. Encourage members to stay in touch with each other and other prospects
3. Share information about resources projects, and events relevant to myMISSION
4. Report accomplishments of individually involved members

myMISSION Group Leader

1. Lead group participants to set goals and implement action plans for accomplishing the groups purpose and providing missions experiences
 2. Encourage members to stay in touch with each other and other prospects
 3. Guide members in developing their leadership potential
 4. Maintain records and report accomplishments
