As part of the audition process, you will need to prepare a song to sing. It can be sacred or secular and can be with or without CD trax, however, we will not have an accompanist available. You will also be asked to sing from a lead sheet and harmonize with another person.

As with all auditions, we will not be able to use everyone. The purpose of this audition is to find singers who can best enhance the current praise team and help to form any teams that may be added in the future. If you are not chosen to be part of the team at this time, please do not take it personally. I would ask that you continue to “lead from your seat in the congregation” and help those around you worship. We need people leading from the congregation as much or more than from the platform.

You will receive a letter within two weeks of your audition with the results.
