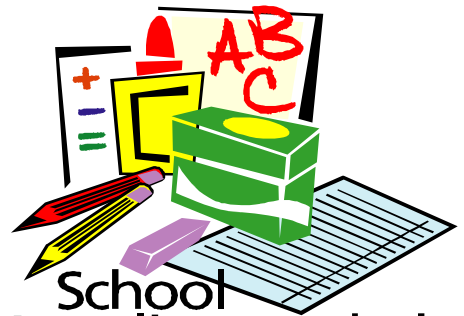


Home Made Ice Cream and Games!
