

GOD'S STILL WORKING ON ME

Phil. 3:13-14

The Apostle Paul gives us a powerful passage that sets the foundation for revival to take hold in our lives.

There are at least two dimensions to his message.

I. SOME THINGS THAT WE NEED TO FORGET AS WE ANTICIPATE REVIVAL.

- (a) The first I would suggest is for you and for me to learn to forget our resentments.
- (b) Secondly, I would suggest that we forget our worries.
- (c) We could also learn to forget about our privileges.
- (d) We also need to learn to forget about our failures.
- (e) We also need to learn to forget our victories and our achievements.

II. THERE ARE SOME THINGS THAT WE NEED TO REMEMBER.

- (a) We need to remember the paradoxical nature that we have.
- (b) I hope also that in these revival days you and I will remember some of the difficult times we have experienced in the past.
- (c) Remember also the available strength that each of us has.
- (d) I hope also that you and I will remember to be more merciful.
- (e) I hope we shall also remember with Paul to persevere.
